Challenges for the Private Sector


Why Should Companies Cooperate?

Alignement of Goals


Common Objectives between the State and Businesses?

- The private sector and the state share a common interest in societal well-being.
- Different approaches: Shareholder vs. Stakeholder.
- Convergence: Sustainability-oriented companies can share similar goals with the state.

Creating Favorable Conditions: The Role of the State


• The state must create conditions that benefit the private sector as well.

• Highlighting shared values and responsibilities.




The Role of Statistical Offices •How Public Statistics Can Help?

- Statistical offices provide the best available data.
- For the private sector, it's not just about reducing effort.
- It's about creating value for all, boosting competitiveness and prosperity.



The Swiss Example

- Collective decision-making by ministries to collaborate.
- Retaining sovereignty while sharing data in a controlled way.
- Example: "Data Mesh" (data market).




Proposal: Metadata Catalogue

• Create a common metadata catalogue for existing data.



- The private sector will also include machines acting on behalf of companies.
- Understanding these mechanisms is key for the future.
