# State of play



## Our experience in cooperation with other public agencies

ONA-Destatis cooperation based on *MoU*

Quality of *ONA-Destatis* cooperation varies

Common goal: *high-quality statistics*

New EU regulation *clarifies NSI role*

*Level of cooperation varies:* some but not all NSIs act as data stewards

# New potential



## Data Governance Act: potential for new type of cooperation

Main intentions are

- to make previously **unavailable public data** accessible,
- to discover **unknown potential**, and
- to **enable innovative business ideas** with benefits for all

DGA has great potential

- Starting point to realize **basic requirements for data exchange**
- Relevant player in the **data ecosystem**

Assuming role is in our own interest

- **Better access** to administrative data
- **Risk management**

# Challenges



## Data Governance Act: what needs to be considered?

**Clarification** of objectives and requirements of the EU regulation

*Requirements and services* **on national level** have to be identified

Build up a **separate and independent DGI unit** within the NSI

Realise the **added value for statistics** by close cooperation

**Trade-off** between additional services and official statistics

## The vision: a DGA centre, that ...

*develops principles* for metadata and IT exchange formats;

»Unlock the power of data«

provides a *broad overview* of (hidden) public data;

build up *new networks* within public services;

has an impact on *new datasets*;

»Get ahead of the curve«
